1) Think of a sentence: e.g.-my sister is called sally

2) Make up your password from the first letter of each of these words. E.g.-my sister is called sally, msics

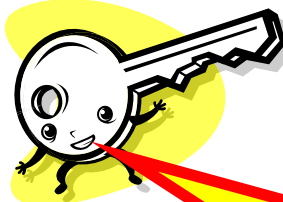
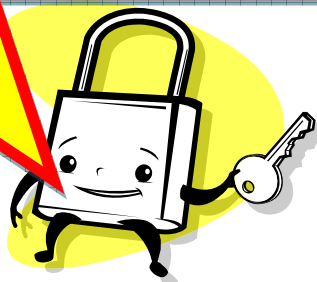
3) Try and use a mixture of uppercase and lowercase letters, even if it's just in a pattern between the two:
MsIcS

4) If you can, substitute some of the letters for numbers to make the password harder to guess. For example:
M5Ic5

5) Check your password on a password strength checker such as: www.passwordmeter.com or www.passwordstrengthchecker.net
