TV adverts

- Toyota, Orange, Vodafone, Ballygunn Spring water and Kit Kat have all made adverts showing the Loch Ness Monster.
- In the Toyota advert the monster grabs one of the cars from the shores of the Loch, disappears beneath the surface and then it is later seen spitting the car back out.
- Another car advert shows a jigger looking at a life-sized cut out of a car by the edge of the Loch before he is snatched by the monster – never to be seen again!
