



	<p><i>Teacher demonstration: Inserting sounds into a presentation</i> Discuss where to find sound files, for example, sounds are available in the clipart/sounds library, or may be downloaded from the Internet. Discuss and demonstrate how to find sound files on the internet, how to save them and how to insert them into their presentation.</p> <p><i>Individual activity: developing their presentation by adding sound</i> Students should open their presentation and begin adding appropriate sounds to enhance their work.</p> <p>Students should access the video tutorials to try to find out how to do things for themselves before asking for help: <a href="http://www.teach-ict.com/software/ppt/powerpoint.htm">http://www.teach-ict.com/software/ppt/powerpoint.htm</a></p>	<p>5 mins</p> <p>20 mins</p>
<p><b>Review/ Summary</b> At least 5 minutes before end.</p>	<p>Interactive bingo from the teach-ict.com site. Ask students to explain a few of the terms. Remember to print out cards before the lesson</p>	5 mins
<p><b>Extension work</b></p>	<p>Students working at lower levels often have difficulty in choosing and inserting appropriate sound effects. They may need more guidance and prompting with selecting sounds.</p> <p>Students working at higher levels could be introduced to more technical details including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• recording and manipulating their own range of sound effects</li> <li>• recording a voiceover for a different audience, for example, an automated presentation.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Homework</b></p>	<p>Hand out a printed copy of the homework to each student.</p> <p>Choose three contrasting advertisements on TV and write a short paragraph about each of them, explaining: The purpose of the advertisement, for example, giving information, advertising a product</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The audience for the advertisement, for example, car owners, football fans</li> <li>• What sound was used</li> <li>• How the sound captured the attention of the audience</li> <li>• How the sound complimented the message of the advertisement.</li> </ul>
