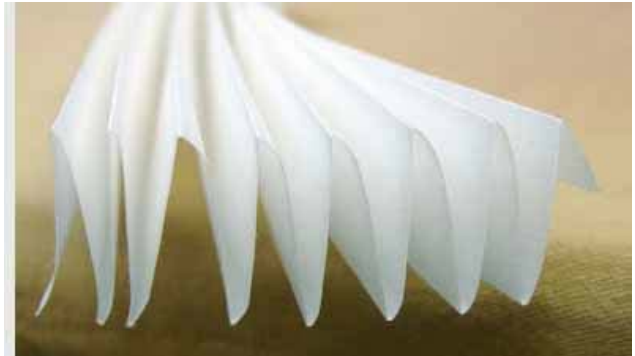


Turn it down

Do you remember playing the game at school where you started with a piece of paper and you wrote a statement?

You folded the paper down to hide what you had just written and then passed the paper to the person next to you. They added a statement and then folded the paper to cover their work.



And so it continued until everyone had written something and the whole thing was revealed, often to much hilarity.

This starter follows much the same rules as the old favourite.

Instructions

- Give each student a copy of the sheet of paper below.
- Each student then has to write something about the topic at the top of the sheet of paper. When instructed, they fold the paper over and pass it to their next door neighbour on the right.
- Everyone then has to write something different to their previous statement - otherwise you will end up with lots of identical sheets. It also makes students have to think about the topic in more depth.
- Continue doing this around five times or until you think they have run out of ideas.
- Students should unfold their sheets when instructed.
- In pairs or small groups, they should read their sheet to each other.
